

Day 1

Arrival at Angers station. Dinner and night at the hotel with breakfast. Departure the following morning at 09:00.

Day 2



25 km | Saint-Aubin-de-Luigné to Thouarcé

Morning: Discover the vineyards of Angers and explore the Village of artists and winemakers in Rablay-sur-Layon. Visit the designer-owned shops and admire the work of craftsmen.

Lunch in the heart of the vineyards at **Terrasses de Bonnezeaux**.

Afternoon: Admire the **Château de Fesles**, a uniquely preserved heritage, and put your bike down for a tour and tasting. The winegrowers will be delighted to let you explore the vineyards around the property and the splendid barrel cellar where their prestigious cuvées are aged.

Dinner and night at the Clos des 3 Rois - 3* Bed and Breakfast.

Day 3



25 km | Thouarcé to Saint-Melaine-sur-Aubance

Morning: After this sweet night, don't miss the Château de Brissac, the highest castle in France, still home to the Brissac Family.

Lunch in Brissac-Quincé at the restaurant L'Ardoise.

Afternoon: You can visit Château d'Avrillé and taste some exceptional wines. Discover a place steeped in history and enjoy the panoramic views from the gardens.

Dinner and night at the **Demeure de l'Aubance** - a magnificent Bed and Breakfast in the heart of the charming village of Saint-Melaine-sur-Aubance.

Day 5



25 km | Denée to Saint-Aubin-de-Luigné

Morning: Along this itinerary, pretty villages follow one another: Savennières, Béhuard and also La Possonnière,... This route is an opportunity to discover the pretty port of La Possonnière and its traditional boats.

Lunch in a traditional restaurant on the banks of the Loire.

Afternoon: Put your bike down for a trip on a Loire River boat. Head to the final point of this itinerary: The charming village of Saint-Aubin-de-Luigné.

Day 6

Dinner and overnight with breakfast at hotel in Angers.





35 km | Saint-Melaine-sur-Aubance to Denée

Morning: Admire the natural landscapes of the Loire as you cycle to the Mediterranean garden at St-Gemmessur-Loire. Take a short diversion to the lovely island of Béhuard, and keep cycling up to the village of Savennières, famous for its dry white wine.

Lunch in Savennières at the restaurant.

Afternoon: After a stroll around Savennières, a 'little city of character', enjoy a wine tasting session at the Vignoble de la Coulée de Serrant. This family property is one of the emblematic vineyards of the Savennières AOP, renowned for the quality of its wines.

Dinner and night at the Bed and Breakfast O Bord de Loire.
