Before dinner, take advantage of the 17-hectare park with its century-old trees, the spa and the many on-site activities (tennis court, yoga classes, hammam and spa, jacuzzi, etc.).

Dinner at the gourmet restaurant L'Orangerie at Château de l'Épinay.

Night at Château de l'Épinay. Enjoy a spacious, elegant and unique room.

Day 2



70 km | Saint-Georges-sur-Loire to Beaulieu-sur-Layon

Morning: Discover charming winegrowers' villages on the wine route: Chalonnes-sur-Loire, Ardenay and Thouarcé. Wine tasting at the wine estate Château de Fesles in Thouarcé. The winegrowers will be delighted to let you explore the vineyards around the property and the splendid barrel cellar where their prestigious cuvées are aged.

Lunch at Les Terrasses de Bonnezeaux in Thouarcé, a gourmet bistro serving traditional cuisine in the middle of the vinevards.

Afternoon: Arrival at the Château Soucherie Bed and Breakfast in Beaulieu-sur-Layon. Enjoy a visit and wine tasting. In the Loire Valley, 20 minutes south of Angers, Domaine de la Soucherie is a historic 28-hectare wine estate producing Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée (AOC) wines from Anjou, Savennières, Coteaux du Layon and Chaume.

Dinner at La Table de la Bergerie restaurant, 1* Michelin, Champ-sur-Layon.

Night at Château Soucherie in Beaulieu-sur-Layon. Beautiful views of the vineyards from each guest room. Roger-François and Pascale Beguinot designed this house to make it an ideal place to rest and relax.



Day 3

60 km | Beaulieu-sur-Layon to Brissac-Quincé

Morning: Head for the **Domaine de Bois Mozé** in Coutures. Discover a terroir full of character, with flamboyant grape varieties that produce prestigious vintages.

Lunch in Brissac-Quincé at the restaurant L'Ardoise.

Afternoon: Visit the Château de Brissac: the tallest château in France. With its 7 floors and 204 rooms. Brissac deserves its nickname of "Giant of the Loire Valley". After this visit, drop off your bags at the Confidences Escale guest room.

Dinner at the Loire & Sens gastronomic restaurant in Juigné-sur-Loire. The restaurant is set in lush greenery. It boasts a spacious and elegant setting, lit by an immense glass roof.

Night at the Bed and Breakfast Confidences Escale. Completely renovated in 2022 by Corinne and Nicolas, "Confidences Escale à Brissac" welcomes you to this superb 18th-century building, formerly the village school, located in the heart of Brissac. 250 metres from its famous château.

Day 4
