## Day 1


 15 km | From Angers station

**Afternoon:** For this trip in the heart of the vineyards of Angers, you will be staying at the 4\* **Loire & Sens hotel** in Juigné-sur-Loire (15 minutes from Angers train station). Set in the heart of a wooded park, Loire & Sens was built in a building dating from the 17th century. Everything has been designed for your comfort. Loire&Sens has 35 rooms, a gourmet restaurant and a wellness area with indoor swimming pool.

**Dinner** at the gourmet restaurant Loire & Sens.

**Night** at Loire & Sens hotel.

## Day 2

 62 km | To and from the hotel

**Morning:** Discover the Loire Valley on board the **vineyard train**. Enjoy a guided tour. Along the way, the landscape reveals all its beauty: the hillsides, the Loire, the mills, the built heritage... You'll be able to hear what the guide has to say: the driver who knows everything there is to know about the vineyards. At the end of the morning, a winegrower will welcome you to his estate "**Domaine Marçais**" to introduce you to his work and the local appellations.


**Lunch** in a restaurant on the banks of the Loire.

**Afternoon:** After this gourmet break, experience an original tour on the smooth and comfortable traditional "toue cabanée" (cabined flat-bottomed barge). Enjoy the view of the Loire and a glass of Chenin on **The Chalandoux** or **Terre & Loire boat**.

**Dinner and night** at Loire & Sens hotel in Juigné-sur-Loire.



## Day 3

 43 km | To and from the hotel


**Morning:** First, follow Valérie, **Les Vignes selon Val**, on a guided walk through the estate's vineyards to learn about the grape varieties and the work in the vines used to make Aubance Valley wines. Afterwards, Perrine from **Domaine de Haute Perche** will welcome you to the cellars for a tasting of 5 wines linked to the walk.

**Lunch** at **Les Terrasses de Bonnezeaux** in Thouarcé. The restaurant proposes a market cuisine made with fresh local produce.

**Afternoon:** Visit the **Château de Brissac**: the tallest château in France. With its 7 floors and 204 rooms, Brissac deserves its nickname of "Giant of the Loire Valley".

**Dinner and night** at Loire & Sens hotel in Juigné-sur-Loire.

## Day 4

 54 km | To and from the hotel

**Morning:** Explore the **Château de Serrant**, home to one of the finest collections of furniture and artworks, including a library of 12,000 books and fully equipped kitchens.

**Lunch** at the Château. Discover local specialities in an exceptional setting.

**Afternoon:** Enjoy a team activity at the château of Serrant in which you learn about Loire wines while having fun. On the programme: various themed workshops, interactive quizzes and card games, and a tasting of 4 wines. After this activity with **Master Grappe** and before setting off again, don't forget to take a stroll in the castle grounds.

**Dinner and night** at Loire & Sens hotel in Juigné-sur-Loire.

## Day 5

End of the trip. Return day.
